

Prexcyt Quest: The First Cryptex Hunt Solution Guide

Theatre

The Director and Actor give some important clues:

Director: **Places**, everyone! And remember: **no titles!** We're all equal here! Now... **act** naturally!
Actor: walks to the center of the stage, takes a deep breath, and **slips into character**.

Each of the lines quoted by the Actor is a well-known quote from the play of Shakespeare. Tracking down the quotes to where they occur, specifically the Act number, and the character (ignoring titles) who said them. Then indexing the character name by Act number:
