

## Prexycy Quest: The First Cryptex Hunt Solution Guide

### Simon Says

In this booth, you're presented with a game in the style of Simon, where you have to work your way through remembering the proper order of 12 colors, revealed one by one. Once you successfully work through 12 levels, you're presented with a grid of letters.











(Unrelated trivia, the tones are those from *Close Encounters of the Third Kind*.)

The game is randomly arranged for each playthrough, so the following is just an example:

Example sequence:

Blue, Red, Blue, Black, Black, Blue, Black, Green, Black, Red, White, Green

Example grid:

	L	P	Y	U	B

To solve the puzzle, you need to look up each pair of colors as (x, y) or (column, row) in the table. In this example, the first two: (Blue, Red) = "G"; (Blue, Black) = "A"
